



Definitions:

Archaeologist • person who studies artifacts made by humans in the past

Art historian • person who researches works of art

Artist • person who creates art, such as paintings, drawings, or sculpture

Cast • plaster reproduction or copy of an artwork

Figurine • small ornamental statue or figure

Maquette • mock-ETTE • smaller version of a sculpture that is part of the design process

Model • smaller scale version of an artwork or building

Mold • form or shell used to make casts and copies

Pediment • triangular shape at the top of a structure

Polychromy • POL-ee-chrome-ee • decorated with many colors

Rendering • producing a reproduction or copy, often virtual or 3D

Replica • an accurate copy usually created for educational purposes to learn about or honor the original

Scientist • person who studies the natural and physical world

Speculative • intellectual guess based on theory and present knowledge
